Patron Survey

At the September School Board Meeting, the Board of Trustees requested that the school conduct a survey of the community on two different issues.

The first issue is on if the District should approve conducting a study to consolidate the Midvale and Cambridge School Districts.

Please contact the school and give your opinion on whether to conduct a consolidation study or not. **Note:** we are not asking whether you favor consolidation. This is to determine if there is interest to conduct the study. If there is interest and if the Board votes to conduct this study, then the process will begin. If the study shows that consolidation would be beneficial to both communities, then a consolidation election will be held in both communities. Your vote on consolidation will be strictly confidential.

The second issue is to decide if the District should pursue re-zoning the school trustee district.

At the present time the zones are very unequal in population. Idaho Code 33-313 states “the boundaries of the several trustee zones in each such school district shall be defined and drawn so that, as reasonably as may be, each such zone shall have approximately the same population.”

At the last count of each zone, the population was as follows:

- Zone #1 (Betty Blendu) had 78 voters
- Zone #2 (Carol Wolfe) had 60 voters
- Zone #3 (Steve Sutton) had 92 voters
- Zone #4 (Dennis Holmes) had 53 voters
- Zone #5 (Jerry Lunsford) had 108 voters

Please contact the school and give your opinion on if the board should pursue re-zoning the trustee zones. If the Board decides to re-zone, they must submit a proposal to the State Board of Education. If the State Board approves the proposal, than an election will be held for the voters to decide to re-zone.

You may call the school any time between the hours of 8 am to 4 pm, Monday through Friday and give us a yes or no vote on conducting a consolidation study and a yes or no vote on re-zoning the trustee zones. One phone call per person.
